- c. Ideas for the Toolkit, considering practical guides and support materials for journalists and the community; d. Main activities and sequence; at this point, a list of the main activities to be carried out throughout the project was established and their logical sequence for execution; the expected

results of the project were defined, including tangible products and desired impacts on the educational community;

e. Main tasks of each partner; the mobilities and their possible dates were discussed, as well as the number of people involved; the issue of funding for each project management mobility was addressed. ----

After the presentation, the first mobility to Portugal and the date of the event were agreed, with the dates being 15 and 16 April. Within two weeks, each partner will have to set up social media accounts for the project, as well as a website and the eTwinning platform.

Finally, in order to give the project greater visibility and identity, it was agreed that a logo would be created by the students. Each partner will select the best proposal to be voted on by the school communities.

There being no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned.
