The meeting began by welcoming all the partners. The coordinator began by presenting the tasks that each school will have to implement in September and October, in preparation for the LTT to Italy in November.

Each partner has to test the toolkit on the site to see how effective it is in building a data journalistic report. To this purpose, lesson plans should be implemented regarding to provide teachers with a suite of comprehensive resources and teacher training materials within the toolkit. These lessons will focus, digital and media skills, will be essential to allowing students to access, analyze and present data journalism.

As had already been agreed during the mobility to Portugal, each partner will develop a unit of work and lesson plans according to the literacy already distributed.

Teachers Rui and Cláudia then presented proposals for planning thematic units on the following Literacies: Information, Maths, Digital and Media. The aim is for all partners to adopt the same thematic unit and lesson structures so that results can be compared.

The theme of the workshop to be held in Italy was suggested, the Italian students will be working on the theme of Bees: fundamental animals for the sustainability of the planet. In this way, each partner will develop a unit of work dedicated to the bees of their country. They will have to collect information such as statistics and news on the subject, presenting a selection of information from digital sources, in order to apply the toolkit. The students will be divided into groups and each group will discuss, developing a data report on bees from each country. It was also suggested that each partner apply this unit in order to test its effectiveness.

On the last point, the fourth virtual meeting was scheduled for 20 September to start implementing the work units.

Finally, all the doubts that arose were clarified.

There being no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned.
